


Adding Exceptions to the Pop-up Blockers for InPort Editor Help Page Access

The most common issue as to why the InPort Editor Help will not launch seems to be due to the browser pop-up blockers. Each browser is slightly different in how you would add the InPort website as an exception to the blocker. Here are the instructions for several of the most common browsers (on a 32-bit system running Windows XP).

Google Chrome


- Go to the settings wrench on the top right of the browser window
- Select Settings from the pull down menu
- From the Setting navigation frame on the left, select Under the Hood
- From the Under the Hood categories, press the Content settings... button in the Privacy section
- From the Content Settings categories, press the Manage exceptions... button in the Pop-ups section



- Type in "inport.nmfs.noaa.gov" into the Hostname Pattern text box and make sure "Allow" is selected in the Behavior drop down next to it
- Press enter to add the InPort website as an exception to the pop-up blocker
- Type <https://inport.nmfs.noaa.gov/inport/publish> in the URL Address window to log back into InPort Catalog Tools or press the X on the Settings tab at the very top of the browser if you are already logged into InPort on another tab
- FYI – when you do launch the InPort Editor Help option, it may not display in front of your InPort Editor form. Please make sure that it is not hiding on another browser tab or another browser window behind your form.

Mozilla Firefox


- Go to the Tools pull down menu and select Options
- From the Options window, select the Content tab (icon)
- From Content, select the Exceptions button to the right of the Block pop-up windows checkbox. This will launch the Allowed Sites – Pop-ups window



- Type “inport.nmfs.noaa.gov” into the Address of website text box and select the Allow button to add the InPort website as an exception to the pop-up blocker
- Press the Close button to close the Allowed Sites – Pop-ups window
- Press the OK button to close the Options window
- Your InPort Editor Help option should now be able to launch the full help page
- FYI – depending on your Tabs settings in Mozilla Firefox, InPort may be launching the Editor Help page but it may not be readily visible. If you still do not see the full InPort Editor Help after changing your pop-up settings and selecting it from the InPort Help pull down menu, please check whether Mozilla Firefox may have added the Editor Help to either a new tab on your browser or a new Mozilla Firefox window all together.

Microsoft Internet Explorer 7

- Go to the Tools pull down menu and select Pop-up Blocker ► Pop-up Blocker Settings



- Type “inport.nmfs.noaa.gov” into the Address of website to allow text box and select the Add button to add the InPort website as an exception to the pop-up blocker
- Press the Close button to close the Pop-up Blocker Settings window
- Your InPort Editor Help option should now be able to launch the full help page
- FYI – when you do launch the InPort Editor Help option, it may not display in front of your InPort Editor form. Please make sure that it is not hiding on another browser tab or another browser window behind your form.
